Draft Task 1

Each team will have a Team Captain plus as many members needed as constructors, and supporters. The decision will be made at the first meeting for each



Team to clarify the tasks for the 2019 Team Marbles Challenge for each of the Tasks.

In Australia Team captains are encouraged to get people including Ambassadors to like their Facebook page and enrol supporters via www.cosnp.info or on the sheet on the last page; Supporters do not need to attend the event – this allows the team captains to promote the event through their networks - The list below shows the current Facebook pages and the number of likes for each of the CRO's that have express an interest in being involved.

In the first three years in Australia we used the challenge to raise awareness of the event through the teams Facebook pages and the team with the largest increases on their Facebook pages received the most number of points .

Draft Task 2

The team with the most registered supporters receives the most number of points for task 2. Once the challenge gets underway each registered team needs to complete two other tasks. To assist with this task a new twist has been introduced that allows Team Captains to have up to 3 Sponsors, each Team will decide how to make best use of their sponsors.

Draft Task 3: In 2019 the structure for the challenge will be the Kit that was purchased from Kmart in 2017 – the time taken to complete this task will determine the points for each team.

Draft Task 4: Ambassadors roll 50 marbles through the structure – The ambassadors will also be given 60 seconds with Mic to entice supporters to change sides. The table on the next pages shows the times ambassadors took to do this task in 2017.

The team with the lowest points total will go first, followed by next lowest until all teams have had a turn. The time it takes to complete all tasks will determine the points for each team (Ambassadors can have several practice runs prior to starting the official timed run, however if the team needs to change the design of the ramp, the additional time will be added to the team's time to construct the ramp).

Each task that a team completes will earn points for the team, at the completion of the four tasks the team with the most points become the 2018 Team Marbles Challenge Champions and have responsibility to look after Ben the mascot of the Team Marbles Challenge until the 2019 Challenge.



- *The points for 1st place in each task is worth 10 points*
- *The points for 2nd place in each task is worth 7 points*
- *The points for 3rd place in each task is worth 4 points*
- *The points for 4th place in each task is worth 3 points*
- *The points for 5th place in each task is worth 2 points*
- *The points for 6th place in each task is worth 1 point*
